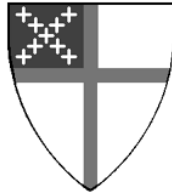

New windows have been installed in the Parish House.

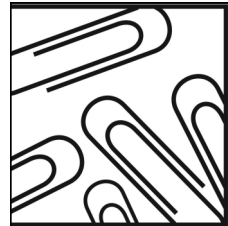
Some outside work is still left to be done after the inside work has been touched up.
